

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING – UPDATE 12/8/2020

Below is notice from York County Solid Waste Authority that they are temporarily ceasing their electronics recycling program due to COVID. Penn Twp therefore would cease their collection of those items.

Any individuals asking what to do with electronics have two options:

- (1) Contact the retailer where the product was purchased or contact the manufacturer directly. They may have programs for recycling.
- (2) Hold those items until the County resumes collection through the program – this may be some time and is not within our local control.

Beginning Wednesday, December 9, 2020, the York County Solid Waste Authority will suspend residential electronics recycling until further notice due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the need to reduce person-to-person contact. Governor Wolf has urged residents to stay at home or work from home and asked that residents travel **only** for essential services. **Essential travel includes things like commuting to an essential job, picking up supplies like groceries and medicine, and checking on family and pets in other households.** Residents who would normally bring their electronic devices to the Authority's free electronics recycling program should hold onto their electronic devices until the pandemic has passed. Once it is safe to do so, the Authority will reopen electronics recycling to residents.
