The snow emergency declared on December 15, 2020 for Hanover Borough **will expire** effective at 10:00 am today, December 17, 2020. The related restrictions will also expire at that time.

Those residents that live along SR 94, SR 194, and SR 116 are asked to be mindful of parking along the roadway that would restrict travel as a large amount of snow still remains within the parking lanes. Vehicles that are not parked within 12 inches of the curb as required by law will be ticketed and may be towed if they interfere with traffic.

Residents are also reminded of the timely removal of snow and ice from sidewalks and that borough ordinance prohibits snow being thrown onto the roadway. Enforcement for sidewalks yet to be cleared will commence at 3:00 pm, Thursday, December 17, 2020 for the downtown business district and at 8:00 am, Friday, December 18, 2020 for the remainder of the Borough.
