

HANOVER BOROUGH
SHADE TREE COMMISSION MINUTES

August 1, 2022

Chairman Rohrbaugh convened the meeting of the Hanover Borough Shade Tree Commission at 9:00 AM Monday morning, August 1, 2022 in the Hanover Municipal Building, 44 Frederick Street, Hanover, Pennsylvania, as advertised.

Attendance: In attendance were Shade Tree Commission members Jill Rohrbaugh, Jane West and Joel Weaver; and Staff Member Secretary Felix.

Approval of the Minutes: It was moved by Mrs. West seconded by Mr. Weaver to approve the minutes of June 6, 2022. Motion carried.

Public Comment: None was presented.

1. Tree Removal Public Hearings:

716 Washington Avenue – Six (6) Bradford Pear trees, and the planting of three (3) to four (4) trees with pending underground utilities check.

- There were no citizens present to object to the removals, so the removal of six pear trees will be forwarded to the Public Works Director for implementation.

2. Permit Applications received that were checked in field prior to meeting:

- 24-28 Baltimore Street: Request for pruning by Borough Crew, due to restriction of visibility to businesses – Approved for Public Works Crew to trim away from roof and elevate over sidewalk, as necessary.
- 109 West Elm Avenue: Request to trim away from sidewalk by Borough Crew, reported by neighbor – Approved for Public Works Crew to elevate over sidewalk, trim sucker shoots and remove deadwood.
- 280 Grant Drive: Request for removal of three (3) dying trees by Borough Crew – Approved removal of three (3) dying trees by Public Works Crew, pending public hearing on September 12, 2022.
- 317 High Street: Approved for Public Works Crew to elevate over street and sidewalk.
- 711 East Walnut Street: Approved for Public Works Crew to elevate over street and sidewalk.
- 938 East Walnut Street: Approved for Public Works Crew to plant two (2) Princeton Sentry Ginkgos.


- 1224 East Walnut Street: Approved for Public Works Crew to elevate over street and sidewalk and remove deadwood. Root killer was recommended for drains.

- 240 York Street – Approved for Public Works Crew to remove three (3) dying trees and plant two (2) Princeton Sentry Ginkgos, pending public hearing on September 12, 2022 and in accordance with pending underground utility check.
