The following are the highlights of the Borough Council's July meetings:

BOROUGH COUNCIL ACTIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Personnel actions:
 1. Approved the position of Administrative Assistant to the Finance Director, reducing the total staffing of the Finance Department by one half position.
 2. Authorized the Civil Service Commission to certify a police eligibility hiring list.
 3. Replaced a full-time, vacant Code Officer position with a part-time position through December 31st, while departmental staffing is evaluated.
 4. Approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the Steelworkers to reclassify one Meterman as a "Lead Man" position.

- Approved Special Event permits including:
 1. Pinky's Barbeque – August 15th - 1 Year Anniversary – Bank Lane

- Approved a "Critical Projects List" to provide direction to staff about the major projects Borough Council is interested in developing.

- Approved a contract extension with Hamilton Musser to audit calendar years 2021, 2022, 2023.

- Approved renewal of a Wildlife Agreement with the Maryland Department of Natural Resources to manage certain Borough owned forested tracts in Maryland.

- Authorized a letter to the York Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (YAMPO) to modify their previous resolution to clarify and indicate support for the 5C alternate route for the proposed Eisenhower Drive Extension project. *(For more information, please visit the Borough's website.)*

- Approved the execution of a research agreement to allocate Growing Greener Grant Funds to the University of Delaware.

- Approved the Subdivision Plan for 228 Broadway/229 East Chestnut Street.

- Approved a long-range capital plan for building projects and authorized a grant funded contract with PFM Group Consulting LLC for \$38,000 to develop a multi-year financial plan to fund capital improvements to Borough buildings.
