PRESS RELEASE: January 27, 2022

BOROUGH COUNCIL ACTIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

MAYORAL PROCLAMATION: Mayor Whitman presented a proclamation to Byers' Butterflake Bakery for their long-term participation in the Hanover Market House upon their retirement from the Market after 53 years.

LIBRARY BOARD REAPPOINTMENTS: Amy Ehrhart and Christine Rosensteel were reappointed as the Library Association Appointee and the Mayor's Library Appointee, respectively, both for three year terms until December 31, 2025.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICES STUDY: A contract for the Professional Services for Fire and Rescue Services Study was awarded to the Pennsylvania Economy League at a cost not to exceed \$80,000, subject to a 50% grant from the Department of Community & Economic Development.

COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS AND COUNCIL/COMMITTEE WORK PLAN: The Council President's Committee Appointments and 2022-2023 Hanover Borough Council/Committee Work Plan were adopted.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS: Advertisement of an ordinance for Main Street Hanover appropriation of funds from the 2022 Hanover Budget was approved.

ORDINANCE TO INCREASE MEMBERS OF RECREATION BOARD: An ordinance to increase membership of the Hanover Borough Recreation Board from five members to seven, one of which shall be a member of the Hanover Borough Council, as delineated in the *Pennsylvania Borough Code*, was approved.

UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE CONTRACT: The Uniform Construction Code Contract for Third Party Building Code Review and Inspection Services was awarded to the Pennsylvania Municipal Code Alliance (PMCA) for two years.

ELIGIBILITY LIST: The Hanover Borough Civil Service Commission was directed to certify an eligibility list from the January 2022 Metropolitan York Police Consortium testing list.

SURGE PROTECTOR/TRANSFER SWITCH: The purchase of a surge protector/transfer switch for the wastewater lift station located on Church Street at a cost of approximately \$50,000 from wastewater fund reserves was approved.
