BOROUGH COUNCIL ACTIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

SPECIAL EVENT: Approval was unanimous for an Easter Sunrise Service at LBS Dan Parking Lot on April 17, 2022.

SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM: The Council created an Agreement with the Hanover Area YMCA for the Borough Summer Playground Program.

PENNDOT'S EISENHOWER DRIVE EXTENSION PROJECT: Council approved a letter from the Hanover Borough Council to PennDOT regarding the Eisenhower Extension Project.

JOINT MUNICIPAL BIDS: Joint municipal bids for materials and supplies were awarded per bid specifications.

UPMC EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM: Council approved the proposal from UPMC for an employee assistance program.

MAIN STREET HANOVER: As appropriated in the 2022 General Fund, funds were approved for Main Street Hanover.

SURPLUS VEHICLES/EQUIPMENT: Approval was granted for the sale of eleven (11) surplus vehicles / equipment at auction.

RECREATION BOARD COMPOSITION: Approval was granted to amend the composition of the Recreation Board from five (5) to seven (7) members. Andrea Hutton was appointed for a term ending December 31, 2025 and Council Member Barb Rupp was appointed for a term ending at the end of her elected term.

QUOTES FOR JULY 4TH FIREWORKS: Approval was granted for the Fire Chief Clouser to obtain quotes for a 2022 July 4th fireworks presentation on North Wilson Avenue and to solicit donations to offset the costs of the event.

SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY: Council approved the Social Media Policy for Non-Uniformed Personnel.

CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION FOR THE INFILTRATION AND INFLOW DEPARTMENT: Approval was granted for the purchase of a Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV)

camera through COSTARS from A&H Equipment for the Infiltration and Inflow Department AT THE COST OF \$12,794.

ENGINE BRAKE RETARDER PROHIBITION: Authorization was granted for the Borough Solicitor to formulate an ordinance and advertisement for an Engine Brake Retarder Prohibition as approved by PennDOT and to post signs along York Street / High Street, Carlisle Street / Baltimore Street, Broadway / Frederick Street, Elm Avenue and Moulstown Road.
