PRESS RELEASE: June 23, 2022**

BOROUGH COUNCIL ACTIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

SPECIAL EVENTS: Approval was granted for the following special event applications:

1. Hanover Chili Cookoff on September 4, 2022 at Moul Field
2. Wedding at Long Arm Dam on September 24, 2022

APPOINTMENTS:

1. Robert J. Dunn, Austin Graham and Brian Johnson were appointed to the Planning Commission for four-year terms until 7.31.26 and incumbent Steve Edwards, was reappointed for a four-year term until 7.31.26.
2. Incumbent Jared Laird was appointed to the Recreation Board for a five-year term until 6.30.27.
3. Andrew Smith was appointed as Library Association Appointee for a term expiring 7.31.23.
4. Mindy Crawford was reappointed to the Hanover Economic Development Corporation (HEDC) for a three year term expiring 7.20.25.

HANOVER MARKET HOUSE LEASES: M&S Country Creations was approved to add one stall and Pam Ross with ceramics and handmade cards was approved as a new vendor with three and one-half stalls.

LIBRARY WORK GROUP: Extension of the Library Work Group monthly meetings was approved through September 2022.

TRAINEE POSITION: Approval was granted to fill a full-time trainee position at the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant per the collective bargaining agreement with AFL-CIO (AFSCME Blue).

COLLECTION PROCEDURES AND ATTORNEY FEES: Approval was granted for Resolution No. 1348 for collection procedures and the adoption of a schedule of attorney fees as part of municipal claims for delinquent water, sewer, trash, fines, and assessment accounts.

QUIET TITLE ACTION: Approval was granted for the Quiet Title action for unopened access off Railroad Street for the property at 229 Carlisle Street.

FINAL MINOR LAND DEVELOPMENT: Approval was granted for Resolution No. 1349 granting Final Minor Land Development for Rutter's at 661-663 Broadway.

EMERGENCY REPAIRS: Authorization was granted for emergency repairs to the property located at 14 Carlisle Street.

KEYSTONE PURCHASING NETWORK: Approval was granted for replacement of the Municipal Building roof by Lobar Associates Construction by the Keystone Purchasing Network (KFN)

TRANSFER STATION HAULING BID: Approval was granted to reject all Transfer Station Hauling bids which were opened May 18, 2022; to extend the contract with Sullivan Hauling until 7.31.22; and to approve advertisement and rebid of the contract for July approval.

VEHICLE PRE-ORDERING: Approval was granted to pre-order Ford vehicles for 2023 including: a marked interceptor hybrid utility and marked F-150 responder for the Police Department; a F-350 utility body with plow for the Public Works Department; and a F-550 utility body for the Water Distribution Department.

LINE PAINTER: Approval was granted for the purchase of a Graco line painter as a necessary replacement funded through the 2022 Public Works budget.

STORMWATER IMPROVEMENT UPGRADES: Approval was granted for Resolution No. 1350 to authorize the Borough Council Vice-President to sign the Contribution Agreement for stormwater improvement upgrades in coordination with the PennDOT Route 194 Paving Project on behalf of the Borough of Hanover.

NOISE ORDINANCE: Authorization was granted to advertise the proposed Hanover Borough Noise Ordinance for consideration at the July 27, 2022 Council meeting.

FIRE CODE: Approval of Ordinance No. 2325 amending the Fire Code as set forth in Chapter 212 of *The Hanover Borough Code* in relation to recreational fires.

RIGHT TURN ONLY RESTRICTIONS: Approval of Ordinance No. 2326 as set forth in Chapter 346 of *The Hanover Borough Code* implementing right turn only restrictions at the intersections of York and Walnut Streets; North and South Franklin at Frederick Streets; and East and West Walnut Street at Baltimore Street; and creating restricted parking on either side of the driveway at 316 Broadway.

MANDATORY TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION POLICY: Approval was granted for a Mandatory Training and Certification Policy for Hanover Borough employees.

FIREWORKS REMINDER: Fireworks are scheduled for Monday, July 4 at 9:30 PM off Wilson Avenue behind Lowe's on Eisenhower Drive.
