BOROUGH COUNCIL ACTIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

SPECIAL EVENTS: Approval was granted for the following special event applications:

1. Snack Town Street Fair on July 15, 2023
2. Diversity Festival change of location from Moul Field to Wirt Park on October 1, 2022

BUDGET DIRECTIVE: The recommendation of the Finance Director for the 2023 Budget Directive was approved.

ASSISTANT BOROUGH TREASURER POSITION: Approval was granted for the replacement hire for the Assistant Borough Treasurer position.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR ABANDONED VEHICLE ORDINANCE: Approval was granted for the advertisement of an ordinance relating to abandoned or junked vehicles.

ARCHITECTURAL CONTRACTS: Approval was granted for an Architectural and Engineering Contract with Buchart Horn for the proposed North Street Public Administration / Public Safety Facility, as well as for the proposed Cougar Drive Extend Public Works / Water Resources Campus.

TRANSFER STATION HAULING BID: The Transfer Station Hauling Bid was awarded by approval to Double W. Farms, LLC for hauling of trash from the Hanover Transfer Station to the York County Solid Waste & Refuse Authority.

CONTROL OF NOISE ORDINANCE: Ordinance No. 2327 was adopted amending the Borough Code for the control of noise.

WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT: The bid for the 2022 Water Main Replacement Project was awarded to EK Services, Inc. for areas of McAllister's St., Waterfront Dr., and Blackrock Rd.

WATER MAIN CLEANING/LINING CONTRACT: The COSTARS contract for the 2022/2023 Water Main Cleaning/Lining Contract was awarded to J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc. for Main St., McSherrystown.

PARKING DEMAND STUDY: The contract for a Parking Demand Study was awarded by approval to THA Consulting, Inc., to be funded through the Capital Projects Fund.

NATIONAL NIGHT OUT: Police Chief Martin invited citizens and the Council to an event at Pet Smart on Wilson Avenue on August 2, 2022 from 6-8 PM.

TRAIL TOWNS DEDICATION: Mayor Whitman related that on Friday, July 29, 2022 at 1:30PM at the Guthrie Memorial Library there will be a dedication for the historical markers for the Heart of Hanover Trail.
