**SENATOR KRISTIN PHILLIPS-HILL:** Sen. Phillips-Hill explained that with redistricting she is now the senator for Hanover and will serve in any way she can. She also explained her current areas of service in the Senate. The Council expressed welcome.

**JCP APPOINTMENTS:** Libby Huston and Thea Zaida Persaud were appointed as Junior Council Persons for two-year terms ending December 31, 2024.

**AFSCME BLUE LABOR CONTRACT:** The AFSCME Blue Labor Contract was approved effective January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2027.

**RESTITUTION SETTLEMENT:** Approval was granted for the restitution settlement in the matter of Commonwealth v. Joyce C. Bardin, Case No. 3051 CA 1989.

JA MYERS VS. BOROUGH OF HANOVER SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT: Approval was granted for the settlement agreement of the JA Myers Building and Development, Inc. vs. Borough of Hanover and the Hanover Borough Council.

JOINT MUNICIPAL BIDS: Approval was granted to award contracts to the lowest bidders for pre-mixed bituminous paving materials; crushed stone; snow and ice rock salt and calcium chloride; petroleum products, chemicals, traffic line painting; waterborne traffic paint; and street milling.

PROPOSED BOROUGH FACILITIES: Approval was granted to accept the Basis of Design plans for the proposed North Street Public Safety & Administration Facility and the Cougar Drive Public Works / Water Resources Campus.

LIBRARY ROOF PROJECT: Approval was granted for Change Order No. 1 for the Library Roof Replacement Contract to provide additional mechanicals for roof access.

NEW SCHOOL ZONE: Approval was granted for staff to move forward with the new school zone for Hanover Street School through PennDOT.

TIME EXTENSION: CHERRY TREE PRELIMINARY LAND DEVELOPMENT PLAN: Approval was granted to accept the JA Myers Building and Development/Royal Building, Inc. offer to grant the Borough an extension of time, until June 30, 2023, for consideration of approval of the Cherry Tree Preliminary Land Development Plan, in accordance with Section 508 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, allowing additional time to address and review comments and zoning hearing conditions.
