

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

BOROUGH COMPLETES NORTH WATERSHED HYDROLOGIC & HYDRAULIC STUDY



The Borough of Hanover Stormwater Authority wanted to develop a comprehensive model to better understand how the stormwater system functions (or doesn't function) and ensure capital improvements project dollars are spent in the most appropriate manner. Penn Township partnered with the Borough to cost share for the study. This study is now being used to layout system improvements to begin addressing localized flooding.

ORDINANCE UPDATE

The Borough of Hanover will be adopting a revised Stormwater Management Ordinance to stay compliant with state regulations and provide a means to promote green infrastructure in the community. The final ordinance, once approved, can be accessed at the Borough of Hanover website.



Jackson Street 2020 Stormwater Project

The Borough intends to construct additional piping and inlets from an alleyway off of Jackson Street towards High Street. This extension of the system will improve stormwater drainage and connect two inlets that currently do not have an outlet pipe into the Borough system. This work will begin once the appropriate PennDOT permits are obtained.
